There is a distinct posterior cusp present, and a very small basal tubercle is usually developed on the posterior border of the cingulum. The small posterior basal tubercle seems to be present more frequently than in the Recent wolves. The protocone is in general not made relatively smaller than in the Recent species through the regular addition of the posterior basal tubercle. The protocone commonly tends to be relatively large anteroposteriorly....
