Jacob Todd is abroad on his own for the first time, visiting his grandfather s grave at the annual commemoration of the Battle of Arnhem in Amsterdam. There, he meets Geertrui, a terminally ill old lady, who tells an extraordinary story of love and betrayal, which completely overturns Jacob s view of himself and his country, and leads him to question his place in the world. Jacob s story is paralled in time by the events of the dramatic day in World War II when retreating troops were sheltered by Geertrui s family. This is an intensely moving and richly layered novel, spanning 50 years, which powerfully evokes the atmosphere of war while brilliantly interweaving Jacob s exploration of new relationships in contemporary Amsterdam.
