This 624-page book also details Barbies family history, the role he played as a Gestapo officer in German-occupied France, his responsibility for the murders of more than 14, 000 Jews and French Resistance fighters during the Nazi Holocaust, his flight from Europe after the war with the backing of the U. S. Government, the Vatican and the International Red Cross, and his settlement in Bolivia with his wife Regine and two children. His nefarious past exemplifies Collective and Personal Evil that is also addressed in this book. The Devils Agent goes deep into Barbies life in Bolivia and relays information that has never been written about, as some of his closest...
