'Light-Bulb Moments' is written for those medical educators who facilitate learning groups using simulated patients (SPs). Its core concern is the interpersonal effectiveness of medical consultations. Half the book deals with the key attributes of practitioner expertise. Throughout, there's an assumption that simulator and facilitator skill is dependent upon learning from experience. As this experiential journey differs from individual to individual as well as between facilitator and SP, a chapter is devoted to elaborating expertise development in a manner suitable for self-development. The sole theme of this colourful and illustrated text is the improvement of real patients' health through high quality clinical and interpersonal engagement. Accounts by other authors illustrate the range of SP involvement in local undergraduate, postgraduate and community care contexts. The light-bulb reflects excitement for all concerned when a revealing insight prompts change in colleagues' interpersonal practice.
